

Entry Guide

Exhibits in the space allocated for each class in the show tent in school field. Exhibits must be staged from 08:00 until 10.30am. Do not put more than one exhibit in any one class.

Staff are there to help you should you need assistance.

Exhibit Ticket for each of your entries with the class number, and your contact number clearly legible (block capitals). For children's classes only, please also include the age of the Child and the exhibitor's name.

Place tickets in half along the dotted line and place under each class number facing up and so your name is not visible.

There is a suggested donation per exhibit via an honesty box on arrival to the tent.

Exhibits must be vacated by 10.30am. The public are not allowed in the show tent while judging is taking place.

1st, 2nd and 3rd place certificates in each individual class and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place certificates for the best exhibits in each overall class.

If there are less than 3 entries in a category, the Judges reserve the right to award certificates according to merit based on their experience.

Winners and runners-up will be awarded prize money. Prize money will be collected from the Show Tent from 4pm. Any prize money not collected will be donated to the Show Funds.

The overall class will also be awarded the associated cup.

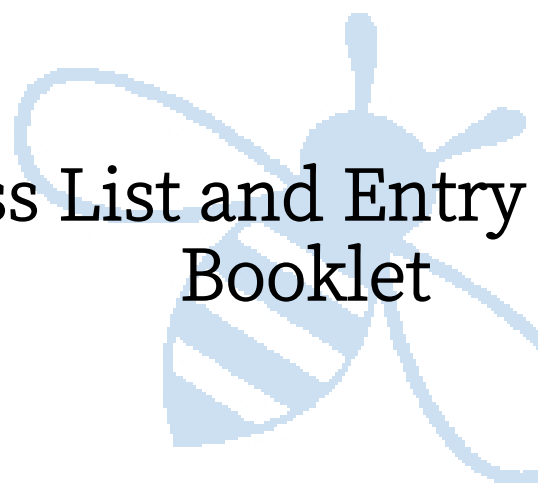
Cups will be presented to overall class winners at 4pm.
