**WOTTON ROAD, CHARFIELD
MAJOR MAINTENANCE WORKS 08 – 26 APRIL 2019**

**PHASE ONE ROAD CLOSURE 08 – 19 APRIL 2019
PHASE TWO TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS 22 – 26 APRIL 2019**

I am writing to advise you about essential roadworks that are to be carried out at Wotton Road, Charfield. From the 08 April 2019, the road will be subject to major carriageway reconstruction works. The works will involve patch repairs to the carriageway surface. The work will start at approximately 7.30am and remain in place until approximately 4.30pm.

These works will create a significant amount of noise.

Between 08 – 19 April, the road will be closed and all traffic will be diverted around the area whilst the closure is in place. The official signed diversion (suitable for all traffic including HGVs) will be B4058 Wotton Road, B4509 Charfield Road, A38 Gloucester Road, Berkeley Road, Taits Hill, Taits Hill Road, The Avenue, The street, B4060 Melksham Court, New Road, Wotton Road, B4060 Stumpwell Lane, B4060 Cotswold Way, Gloucester Street, New Road, B4058 New Road, B4058 Wotton Road and Vice Versa. Access to properties and amenities fronting the site and whose only access is from the closed road, will be available at all times although delays may occur.

It will be possible for traffic to divert via Kingswood and Wickwar but this will be unsuitable for HGVs due to the low bridge and height restriction at Station Road, Wickwar. Every effort will be made to keep the disruption to local residents and businesses to a minimum. Please note that adverse weather conditions or plant / delivery problems may affect these dates and times.

Although the official diversion will be signposted whilst the works are in progress, it is possible that delays may occur on the surrounding network. South Gloucestershire Council apologises for any inconvenience caused by these essential works.
